

# Invitation to Tender

## Artist's eligibility

Artists, who did not complete their age of 35 years before June 1st 2009, will be eligible.

## Works eligibility

Allowed are works on paper with the format of 100x140 cm maximum. Pure, graphically and digitally raw, photography will be exempted. Participants may file 3 optional works, solely at standard form [www.koschatzkykunstpreis.at](http://www.koschatzkykunstpreis.at).

## Subject

There is no limit for the creative spectrum and no thematic guideline.

## Jury

The committee is composed of the jury-members with 1 vote per person. The president of the Rotary Club Wien-Albertina represents the club (organiser) with 1 vote. The quorum for the mention will be the bare majority.

## Procedure of Contest

### 1st of October 2008

The award is being introduced to the public  
Start of tender for the artists

### 15th of October 2008

Start of application via online-form for the artists

### 31st of January 2009

End of the application period

### 1st of February until 28th of February 2009

Preselection by the jury for the final nominees

### Till 31st March 2009

Delivery of the preselected works to the Museum of Modern Arts

### Till 30th of April 2009

Phase of preliminary decision and triage of the invited original works – nomination of about 50 to 70 works (est.) for the exposition and awarding

### 11th until 13th May 2009

Exposition of the nominated works at the Museum of Modern Arts

### 14th of June 2007

Awards show

## Awards

1st prize: €6.000,--

2nd prize: €4.000,--

3rd prize: €2.500,--

Purchases amounting to EUR 5.000,00 are planned by the sponsors and organisers. The final amount of the purchase-budget will be proclaimed in May 2009.

The award-winning works will be acquired for € 1.000,00 (in addition to the price money) and will be transferred to the collection of the RC Wien-Albertina.

## Auction

The Rotary Club Wien-Albertina reserves the right to auction off at a later date any winning works and works that were bought during the public viewing. The auction proceeds will solely benefit the competition itself or the direct support of young visual artists (selected by a judging panel). At such an auction the contestants forego their right to a royalty payment which they would be entitled to in case of auction proceeds of over € 3.000 according to directive 2001/84/EC Austrian copyright legislation.

## Insurance

The works are insured to custom and usance, from the moment of disposal until its return to the artist.

## Sale at exhibition

The exposed works, which were not transferred to the ownership of the Rotary Club Wien-Albertina by purchase, may be disposed at the exposition, but must not be handed out to the purchasers before the last day of exposition. In the case of disposals the expositor (RC Wien-Albertina), he is authorized to withhold the usual commissions of 50%, which will be dedicated to a social purpose, proclaimed in May 2009.

## Framing

The organiser reserves the right to frame and present all works with a method of his point of view, whereas the framing will not be part of the work and will stay in the ownership of the organiser in the case of a disposal. The organiser will attach importance to an adequate framing based on artistic criteria. Each has to be marked on the back side, if the framing and the work form are an inseparable unit.

## Reconsignment

Filed works, which are not distinguished, purchased or chosen for expositions, can be picked up personally at the collection point of the Museum of Modern Arts. By request they also will be delivered per post, at expense of the participants (C.O.D. parcel) using the original packaging material. At the transmittal the adequate packaging for the return transport should be considered. As of August 2009 the organiser is allowed to use the not distinguished works (which were not picked up till the end of July 2009) for charitable purposes (e.g. holding an auction). On a sheet of paper, which is securely attached on the back side, the filed original works should contain the following details: Name of the artist, date of birth, address, telephone number, e-mail address, title of the work, year of origin, used method as well as the amount of the requested purchase price including VAT (in case of a purchase).

## Contest conditions

By attending the, contest the participants agree with the contest conditions and the exclusion of the legal action.

## Sponsoring agreement

By attending the contest, the participants agree with any contracted sponsoring conditions and also agree to PR and marketing (considering arts adequate usage) under exclusion of the legal action.

## Organiser

The gallery is opened from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. For any other forms of delivery, it is important to deliver the works not later than the 30th of March 2009 at the gallery mentioned above. Otherwise the possibility of attendance will decline.
